GOD'S SIGN LANGUAGE

Later Sunday in our church, and in churches all over the world, there is a person who uses sign language to communicate with persons, with disability of hearing and also speaking. A recent development on our T.V screens and in watching movies is the person called a "signer" who communicates information to deaf people, through his hands, eyes and lips The first reading Isaiah–35:4–7 is using the image of a deaf person to show us what God would one day do for his people.

In the days of the Old Testament we read time and again that the Israelites had shut their ears and no longer listened to the Lord. To-day are we any better to listening attentively to the word of God, and more importantly translating the Word of God into meaningful action? This is the challenge we face to-day as followers of Christbeing faithful to his word, and following the road map which leads us to eternal life.

The writers of the Word of God used the wretched situation of the lame, the blind, the deaf, the epileptics and the lepers as examples to describe our alienation, our separation from God .The healing, in turn of these people is the sign of God's powerful and the presence of his love and care for each one of us.

Therefore we resemble the above unfortunate people who are in dire need of healing and love. Our prayer today, therefore is that the Lord may open our ears to listen to his message.

Lets us not procrastinate, let us remove the stubbornness and hard heartedness from our being and respond to the love of God with generous hearts. God's wonderful works are in signs all throughout the history of humankind, which is the history of our salvation in our favor
